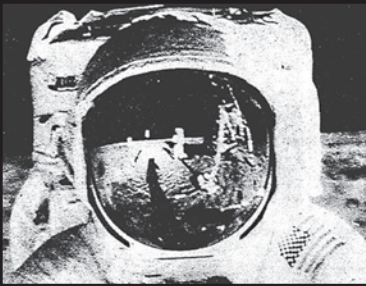

JACK THE RIPPER.
A London Murder Causes Another
BOA.
LONDON, Oct. 31.—The "Jack the Ripper" scare has again caused a sensation among the police and residents of the Southhampton locality. To-night in a secluded part of that neighborhood passers-by were shocked by finding in an obscure alley the dead body of a woman whose head had been very nearly severed, while her body showed evidences of kicks and bruises in themselves sufficient to cause death. While up to the present time no knowledge has been obtained as to who the victim was, it seems very evident that she was a woman of low repute, and this was sufficient to start the cry "Jack the Ripper has been at work again." The police actively began operations in a search for the murderer, but thus far no arrests have been made.
